• To identify and develop new partnerships and funding/sponsorship opportunities for the company. Working closely with the Chief Executive to identify and develop new partnerships and funding to propose and write funding applications to trusts and foundations.

• To support the coordination of major projects, negotiate financial contracts with creatives and manage freelance producers/creatives employed for such projects.

• Together with the Artistic Director/ Chief Executive to act as a senior advocate for the company within the locality, the sector and nationally.

• Together with the Artistic Director/Chief Executive to actively promote and ensure the implementation of Utopia Theatre's Equalities, Diversity, and Inclusion Plan.
